

Finance and Comptroller (FC) BOLC Course Overview

Course Length: 12 weeks 5 days

Proponent School: United States Army Soldier Support Institute, Finance and Comptroller School, Fort Jackson, South Carolina

Common Core Training: The Combined Arms Division (CAD) instructs students on various Army programs and drills. Topics covered include:

Leadership and Professional Development Training: The course director and Finance and Comptroller NCOs will instruct students on various Finance and Comptroller tasks. This training also includes instruction from the University of South Carolina (UofSC). Topics covered include:

Field Training Exercise: The exercise is designed to provide students with realistic technical training on essential skills inherent to a Financial Management Support Detachment and Brigade S8. This is a 5-day exercise.

Leadership Opportunities: Officers will rotate through various classroom and field leadership positions throughout the course to assess their leadership potential.

Students may be assigned to one or more of the following administrative or leadership positions during the course: Class Leader, Squad Leader, S1, S2/S3, S4, Academic Officer, Automations Officer, International Officer Sponsor, Physical Training Leader, Safety Officer, and Social Officer.
