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TYPE OF EVALUATION AND SUBJECTS/TASKS COVERED:
GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

1. All tests are scored on a percentage basis with 80% considered passing. 70% for International Officers.
2. Each student, except for International Officers, must achieve an overall course average of 80%. International Officers must achieve an overall course average of 70%.
3. APFT – Each student must pass the APFT with a minimum score of f180 points with at least 60 points in each event.

4. RETESTS

- a. Retests are authorized once on every test a student fails to achieve the 80% (70% for International Officers) minimum standard. The maximum score for a retest is 80% and 70% for International Officers. Students will be provided remediation and retests will not be given on the same day as the initial test failure. Students who fail the retest and/or require extra ordinary assistance will be recommended for dismissal from the course.
- b. Both remedial training and retest will take place after duty hours. Remedial training will take place prior to retesting.
- c. The school Commandant may, under rare and compelling circumstances, authorize extra training during non-academic hours for students who fail a retest and:
 - (1) Are recommended by their class advisor and group instructor.
 - (2) Achieve 225 on the diagnostic and 240 on the record APFT.
 - (3) Be in the top two-thirds of the class academically.

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GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

5. The top 20% of the students may be recognized by having block 13a, EXCEEDED COURSE STANDARDS, marked on their DA Form 1059, Service School Academic Evaluation Report. The following minimum criteria must be met:

- a. Overall academic average of at least 90% and having passed all tests on the first attempt (with exception of Land Navigation Course).
- b. 270 or higher on the APFT with at least 90 points in each event. Students with a permanent profile for a specific event(s) will automatically receive a score equal to their lowest score on the testable events. This score applies only toward the Commandant's Listing standing (Exceeded Course Standards); it will not be the official APFT score, and this officer will not be eligible for the Physical Fitness Award for the class.
- c. Have at least three "SUPERIOR" ratings marked in block 14 or DA Form 1059. LEADERSHIP SKILLS must be one of the "SUPERIOR" ratings.
- d. Performance/behavior free of any display of unprofessional conduct.
