


Uniform Requirements

Uniform Requirements: Officers are responsible for procuring and maintaining uniforms appropriate to their assigned duties. The Financial Management School recommends active and reserve personnel possess the items listed below. If you do not have these uniform items, you may purchase them while at Fort Jackson. There will be at least one formal social function while your course is in session. The ACU uniform will be the primary class uniform during the course. Listed below are the minimums/components needed of each uniform.

Uniform Notes:

- § ACUs must have name tape, U.S. Army tape and rank. All PCS students will wear the SSI patch. Since AGR students are not in a PCS status they will wear their command patch and DUI from their normal duty station.
- § The black beret will be worn by students. The only time when officers may wear their patrol cap with subdued or sewn on rank is when they are in the field'
- § Students will wear their rank sewn on their kevlar cover. Additionally, they will also wear their name sewn on their kevlar band and it will be dummy corded to their kevlar. Students will be issued a kevlar cover, though it will not have rank sewn on it.
- § The New Army Improved Physical Fitness Uniform (AIPFU) must be worn at FMCCC. An orange reflective belt is required as a component of the AIPFU. It will be provided to each student during their CIF issue and is also available from Clothing & Sales for approximately \$6.15.
- § Ample opportunity is available to enjoy the local area and have fun. Appropriate civilian/leisure attire will be needed for the course. Additionally, you will want to bring at least one semi-formal outfit (suit for men/dress or pantsuit for women) in the event your class is invited to a community event requiring such attire. Periodically, the Columbia Chamber of

Commerce hosts such an event where students are invited to interact with leaders of the Columbia community.
