



Application: Enterprise Resource Planning with SAP TERP10 Course

Description: This program is designed to provide students with an overall understanding and a working knowledge of the function, design, control, and use of ERP systems as implemented by the Federal Government and also by its suppliers. Students will get an understanding of their own technology, as well as the technology of the entities which they interact. The curriculum provides students with the conceptual understanding and applied skills to be able to navigate the complexities of transaction processing and data queries inherent in modern ERP systems. Courses: Financial Accounting, Application of Advanced Databases to Accounting and Business, Accounting Information Systems from a Strategic Perspective, Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) Systems (TERP10).

Note: This program is considered very rigorous and extremely fast paced. During the course, students should expect challenging work on a daily basis. Students will be required to study during the evenings and weekends to keep pace with the program of instruction. Selected candidates must complete approximately 30 hours of preparatory work prior to the first day of class. This is a requirement!
