Colonel Greg Worley enlisted in the United States Army as an Infantryman in 1990. As a staff sergeant, he held numerous platoon level positions in the 82nd Airborne and 101st Airborne (Air Assault) Divisions.

Colonel Worley attended Officer Candidate School in 1997 and was commissioned into Field Artillery. As a junior officer, he served in numerous positions in the 2nd Infantry Division to include Platoon Leader, Battery Executive Officer, and Fire Direction Officer. Greg returned to the 101st Airborne Division (Air Assault), where he served as a Battalion Fire Support Officer during the Iraq invasion as part of Operation Iraqi Freedom, and subsequently commanded two Field Artillery Batteries. As a Major, Greg served as the Regiment Fire Support Officer for the 160th Special Operations Aviation Regiment (SOAR), where he deployed to Afghanistan and Iraq a number of times. After attending the Command and General Staff College, he was assigned to the United States Army Special Operations Command, where he returned to both Iraq and Afghanistan. Greg conducted a branch transfer into Finance and Comptroller and was selected to serve in the 75th Ranger Regiment. While serving as the Regiment Financial Manager, he deployed and served as Chief of Staff of the Counter Terrorist Task Force. Afterward he was selected and attended the Defense Comptroller Program at Syracuse University. Upon graduation in 2014, he was selected to serve as the Director, G8, 82nd Airborne Division and deployed to Operation Inherent Resolve (OIR) where he served as the Combined Joint Force Land Component Command-Operation Inherent Resolve (CJFLCC-OIR) CJ8. Upon his return, Greg was assigned to the United States Army Special Operations Command where he deployed and served as the Special Operations Joint Task Force-Operation Inherent Resolve (SOJTF-OIR) J8. He then attended the Army War College at Carlisle Barracks, Pennsylvania, and went on to serve as a congressional appropriations liaison officer in the Office of the Secretary of Defense-Comptroller. He is currently the 41st Commandant of the Finance and Comptroller School and Chief of the Finance Corps.

Colonel Worley earned a Bachelor of Science in Management from the University of Oklahoma. He also holds a Master of Business Administration from Syracuse University, a Master of Public Administration from Syracuse University, and a Master of Strategic Studies from the United States Army War College. Greg is also a Certified Defense Financial Manager (CDFM) and holds DoD FM Certification Level 3.

Colonel Worley's awards and decorations include Bronze Star Medals, Defense Meritorious Service Medal, Meritorious Service Medal, Afghanistan and Iraq Campaign Medals, Inherent Resolve Campaign Medal, Ranger Tab, Combat Action Badge, Air Assault Badge, and the Master Parachutist Badge.
